A group of residents and councillors have created an emergency plan for the two villages, many people have come forward with suggestions of how they might help in an emergency.

The Emergency Planning officer from Lincolnshire County Council, is helping up with the next stages.

When it is ready, details will be included along with other local information, in a Parish Council booklet & delivered to all homes in the area, it is hoped that we can raise enough money from advertisers to cover the printing costs.

The play area now has large bins & although not completely rubbish free, they certainly help & we hope that those that use it for recreational & dog walking purposes either take their waste home with them or use the bins provided.

The path to the church & the church yard have kindly been cleared by residents & councillors which a brilliant community effort.

Speed limits throughout the villages remains an issue, it is an item on the agenda and it is hoped that highways can help us.
